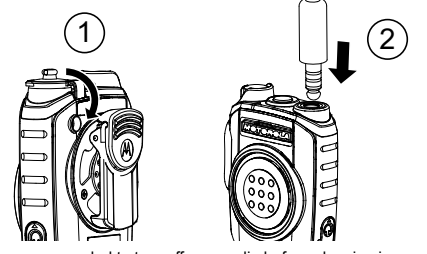

Acoustic Safety

Exposure to loud noises from any source for extended periods of time may temporarily or permanently affect your hearing. The louder the radio's volume, the less time is required before your hearing could be affected. Hearing damage from loud noise is sometimes undetectable at first and can have a cumulative effect. To protect your hearing:

- Use the lowest volume necessary to do your job.
- Turn up the volume only if you are in noisy surroundings.
- Turn down the volume before connecting headset or earpiece.
- Limit the amount of time you use headsets or earpieces at high volume.

- When using the radio without a headset or earpiece, do not place the radio's speaker directly against your ear.
- If you experience hearing discomfort, ringing in your ears, or speeches that are muffled, you should stop listening to your radio through your headset or earpiece, and have your hearing checked by your doctor. To change the volume level, refer to Radio Product Safety Leaflet or Customer Programming Software (CPS) for Surveillance extra loud (xL) Kit Configurations.

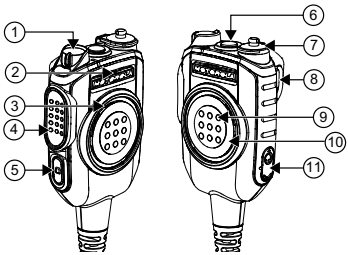

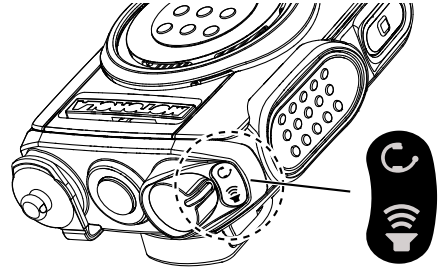

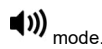

This section provides information on audio switching reminder alarm.

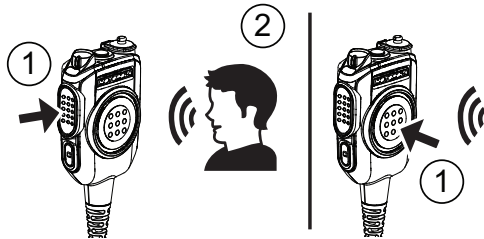
A pulsing audible alarm is heard in the connected Nexus accessories when the audio routing is switched to the



mode. As part of the safety feature to prevent mistaken or forgotten audio switching, the audible alarm is always enabled. You are

recommended to switch the audio to the mode when wearing the Nexus accessory for operation.

Transmitting from RSM



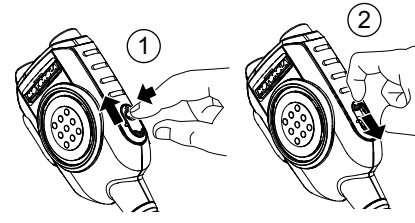
- Press and hold the PTT button.

- Always cover the audio jack with dust cover when it is not plugged in.

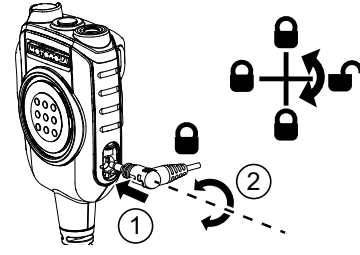
Opening and Closing the Audio Jack Cover



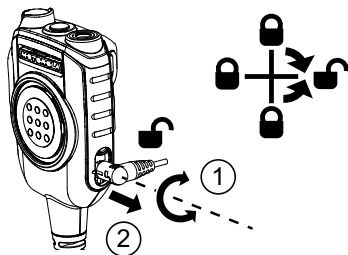

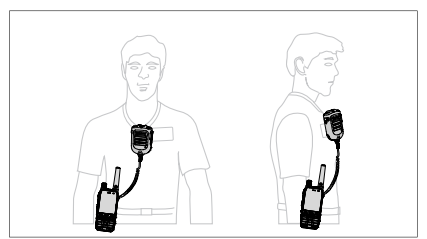

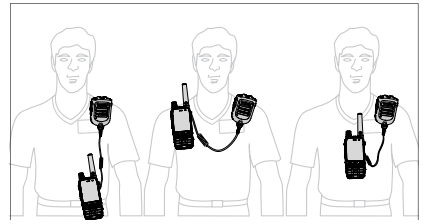

RSM with Short Cable

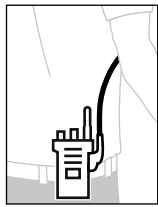

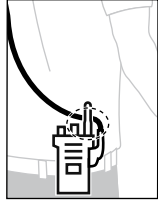
Cable Management

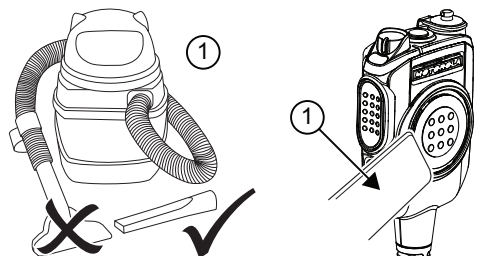
To ensure optimum range and user experience, it is recommended to avoid crossing accessory cable with the radio antenna.

Cleaning Procedures

This section provides information on cleaning procedures for the RSM.

Optional Step for High Debris Environment

Vacuum the front surface of the RSM before general cleaning.



The following voids the warranty:

- Use of more than 4 hp/3 kW vacuum.
- Any nozzle other than a crevice nozzle.
- Any other cleaning method.



Cleaning Procedures

- Ensure that the connector do not get wet.
- Do not fill water into the Nexus jack or the audio jack.
- Cover the Nexus jack or the audio jack with the dust cover when it is not plugged with earpiece.
- If water enters the Nexus jack or the audio jack, remove water by shaking the RSM.

WARNING

Use only dish soap and water. Other cleaning solutions may permanently damage the RSM housing and will void the warranty. Do not soak more than 30 minutes.

1. Mix one teaspoon of mild dish-washing detergent to one gallon of water (0.5 % solution).
2. Apply the solution sparingly with a stiff, nylon, and short bristled brush.

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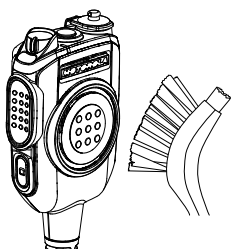
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WARNING

Do not allow the bristles to enter the speaker or microphone porting areas, which can cause internal damage and will void the warranty.

3. Fully rinse the RSM with cold water and dry thoroughly with soft lint-free cloth.
4. Hold the RSM with the front surface down, and lightly shake it a few times to clear out water that may be underneath the speaker openings or microphone ports.
